Mascoma enters supply agreement with Chevron

Mascoma Corp. of Lebanon, N.H., said that it has entered into a feedstock processing and lignin supply agreement with Chevron Technology Ventures, a division of Chevron USA Inc.

"Under terms of the agreement, CTV will provide various sources of lignocellulosic feedstock to Mascoma," Mascoma said in a press release.

"Mascoma will then convert the feedstock to cellulosic ethanol through its proprietary process, which produces lignin as a by-product." (Globe Staff)
